Each guitar will be individually decorated by noted local artists and musicians then placed on display at high-visibility locations throughout the Free State, and all are available for corporate and individual sponsorship.

At the end of the showing, each guitar will be sold at auction, with proceeds from the auction and program sponsorships to be used to purchase instruments and supplies for music programs in our schools and community organizations throughout the state of Maryland.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING:

- Artists may submit only one design.
- Submitted designs will be reviewed by a panel of judges. Chosen designs will be posted on www.music4maryland.com for sponsor/partnership consideration.
- Upon a sponsorship purchase, sponsors will get the option to choose the artist they want to work with or Music 4 Maryland will assign an artist based on submitted designs.
- Collaborative proposals are eligible.
- Artists should keep in mind that the audience for the guitars is broad and made up of all ages.
- Designs should be appropriate for public display.
- Advertising is not allowed.
- Please submit your proposed guitar design on one of the outlines provided.
- Do not send designs larger than 8.5 x 11".

DIRECTIONS CONTINUED...

- The more finished your design is, the easier it will be for the panel to review your submission. Artists may submit a brief artist statement about the concept of their design. Artist statements are limited to **one paragraph**. Artists should indicate on the above application whether or not they are available to share their process with the public during the production of their guitar.
- Artists will be notified on an as needed basis if they are chosen by sponsor or Music 4 Maryland to create a guitar.

GUIDELINES FOR PRODUCTION:

The guitars will be installed with their electrical gear upon completion of the design.

The surface of the guitar is finished by the manufacturer. They have a grey/black background. You may alter the finish of the guitar if you wish to change the color of it.

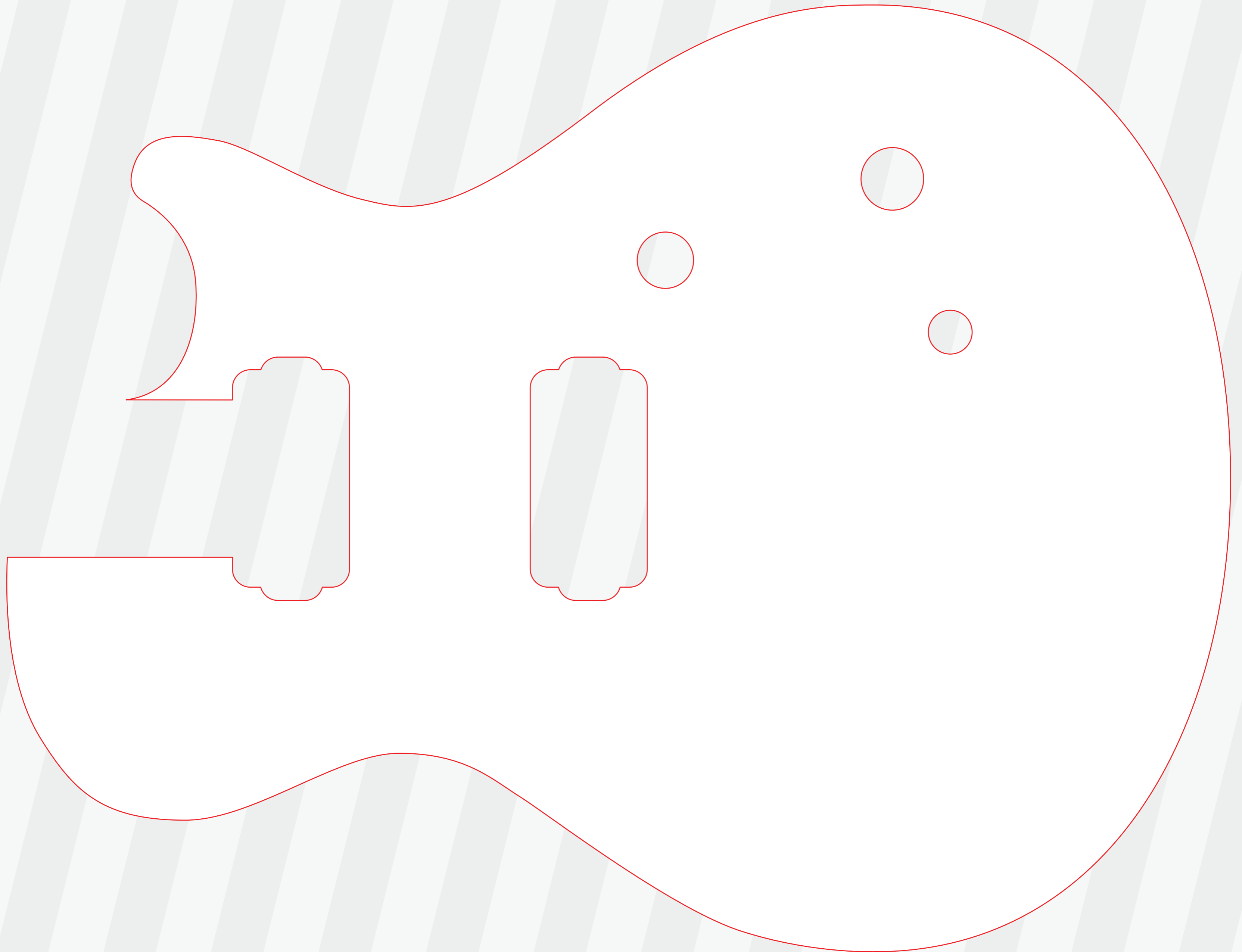
Completed guitars should receive topcoats of varnish. More info will be provided by PRS upon match up with sponsor.

Artists may be asked to be available for touch ups or repairs after the installation of electrical equipment.

NOTES FOR CHOSEN ARTISTS:

A \$200 stipend will be provided to any artist that is chosen to fulfill their design. You may opt to donate this back to the charity or a check will be issued before the end of the campaign on December 1, 2010.
